SIGHT FOR STUDENTS

Children who are in need of eye-care services may qualify for free exams & glasses if they contact the YMCA. This program assists families who earn up to 200% of the poverty level but are not eligible for government programs or able to obtain insurance. MOWER COUNTY MENTORING

Registered mentors with the Mower County Mentoring Program can accompany their mentee to the YMCA free of charge. This gives them the opportunity to spend quality time together as they enjoy the various activities at the YMCA. The mentee is required to have a \$1.00 Youth Membership and the mentors need to identify themselves at the Reception Desk as they enter the facility.
